A Message From Our Spiritual Director

Anne Paden shares an insert from Jack London's amazing story of an animal, half dog and half wolf, and about how he survived his life in the wild, and then learned to live among men.

One story in particular left a lasting impression on my heart, as Anne writes about the dog they named White Fang. White Fang was very fond of chickens and the author told of one occasion where the wolf-dog raided the chicken house and killed fifty chickens. His master scolded him



and then took him in the chicken yard where the dog saw his favorite food. The dog lunged forward, but the master pulled him back. The act continued over and over until his master's voice finally stopped the wolf-dog. He had finally learned to ignore the chickens. The master's friend reminded him "you couldn't cure a chicken killer." But, locked in the yard and there deserted by his master, Fang lay down and went to sleep, once he got up to get a drink of water from the trough, he

calmly ignored the chickens all around him as if they didn't exist, he then jumped on the roof of the chicken house and then to the outside of the pen, he had learned his lesson.

Out of love and desire to obey his master's will, Fang overcame his natural inborn desires. He may not understand the reason, but he chose to bend his will to his master.

Teaming and Sponsorship

Members of the TLC (team leadership committee) must have served on a team at least twice. The Team Selection Committee meets to approve the choices the WLD, with God's guidance, has made.

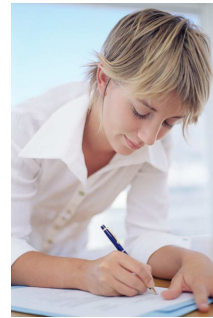
To be selected to be on the TLC is quite an honor but it is also a tremendous responsibility.

The TLC sets the tone for the teaming experience.

Once the TLC has been set, the Team Selection Committee meets again to review the applications of those who wish to serve as a team member and select them. There are very specific guidelines that are followed and with God's guidance the team is selected.

Teaming is an exciting time for all teamers, from seasoned teamers to first-time teamers!

Of course, not everyone is able to make the commitment to team but may one may be able to sponsor a pilgrim. This is a huge responsibility! The first thing one must do before offering sponsorship to someone is to PRAY!!! Remember the Walk



to Emmaus is not a "Fix-It" for someone's problems. The Walk to Emmaus is to strengthen a person's walk with Christ and to create leaders for the church. Sponsorship is like adopting a child! The sponsor is to be sure after the walk that the pilgrim comes to the Day of Deeper Understanding, Gatherings, and finds a Group Reunion to join.

Where is all this leading? The upcoming walks need teamers. Send in your application! The upcoming walks need pilgrims. Pray about it. Get those applications in!
