APPLYING FOR AND BEING SELECTED FOR A TEAM

Probably the majority of us would like to serve on a team, and for most, it is a wonderful experience. There are, however, factors about serving on a team that should be considered. Just as we say that Emmaus is not for everyone in our churches, serving on a team is not for everyone who attends an Emmaus or Cursillo weekend.

First it is mathematically impossible for everyone to be selected. Each weekend, there are usually more members of the Emmaus community produced than would be required for a future team. The committee responsible for making up teams earnestly tries to see that everyone has a turn, but it must work within certain guidelines. One of the guidelines is that a team should have built-in experience. At least half of the members should have previously served on one or more teams and a few key leaders should have been on more than two teams. An effort is made not to have too many members from the same church. More than one team member might be selected from the same area so travel can be shared.

In addition to the guidelines that the committee follows, there are other factors you should consider. First, beyond the Spiritual Directors, Lay Directors, Music Director and Head Servants, people are not selected for specific jobs. No one has the authority to promise you a particular responsibility. Everyone must be willing to serve in whatever capacity is needed. Next, if you accept a team assignment, you are making a commitment to be available for a team meeting once each week for up to eight weeks before that weekend and the given weekend. Availability and sacrifice of time is the real requirement.

Finally, each of us must take into consideration the physical and emotional strains that are sometimes encountered while serving on a team. The joy of being on a team is there, but the work and strains are also. Team members routinely are the first up in the morning and the last to bed at night. Working under pressure is also routine. Everyone on a team must carry his or her full load and be ready, willing and able to share his or her faith and love with any and all others on the weekend.

Again, the joy and the mountain-top experience are there, but so are the climbing and the giving. If you decide that being a team member is not for you, there are many other areas of service in Emmaus. If you have been on a team numerous times, God might be calling you to serve in other areas. You may want to put more effort in Agape, serve on a committee or fill other important jobs that are necessary for a successful Emmaus weekend. There is so much to be done that there is no limit to the opportunities for service. Being on a team may or may not be the best way that you can serve - only you know this. If, after praying about it, your answer is YES, please complete the application. Serving on a team will be a blessing to you and you will be a blessing to others. Pray and listen for God's voice. He will guide you on where He wants you to serve. Whether it is on a team or serving in other areas, you are needed!
