John 19:27 Then He said to His disciple **"Behold your mother"**! and from that hour the disciple took her to his own home. There aren't

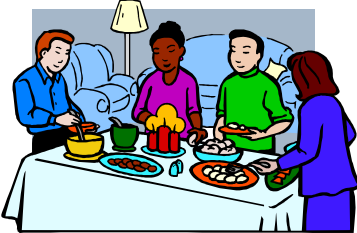

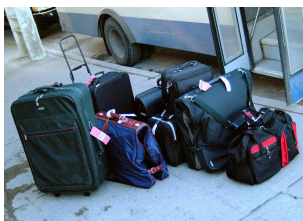
there is plenty of room
