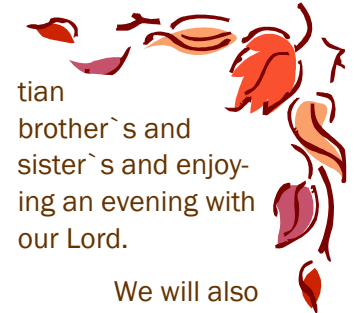
November / A Time for Thanksgiving
